Bicycle Registration

Why should I register my bike?

- It helps find owners if lost, stolen, or confiscated bicycles are recovered.
- Registration is free and easy!

How do I register?

You can register your bike by completing a short registration form at Parking Services between **7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday**. To make your registration time even faster, print out the registration form, and bring the completed form to Parking Services. The registration form must be returned by the bicycle owner.

Parking Services will give you a registration decal, which should be placed on the frame below the seat so that it can be easily seen. Bicycle registration does not expire as long as you are an MSU student or employee.

Where can I ride my bike?

Please remember that MSU parking regulations apply to any individual who rides or parks a bike on campus. State law pertaining to bicycles will be observed, including the requirements of a light shining forward and a reflector in the rear when used at night.

Bike paths should be used where available. If no bike path is available, all bicycles shall be ridden on the right side of the street, and all traffic signals and signs must be observed in the same manner as for motorized vehicles. Bicycles must be rolled or pushed on pedestrian sidewalks and in all pedestrian areas and are not to be ridden.

Where can I park my bike?

Bikes must be parked in racks, which are available at respective buildings. You cannot park any bicycle in a walkway, on a sidewalk, in a hallway, on a handicap ramp, or in a doorway. Any bike found in those locations is subject to impoundment.

Bikes are not allowed in buildings on campus, unless authorized by the Director of Parking in writing. An exception permits residents to store bicycles in their residence rooms on campus.
